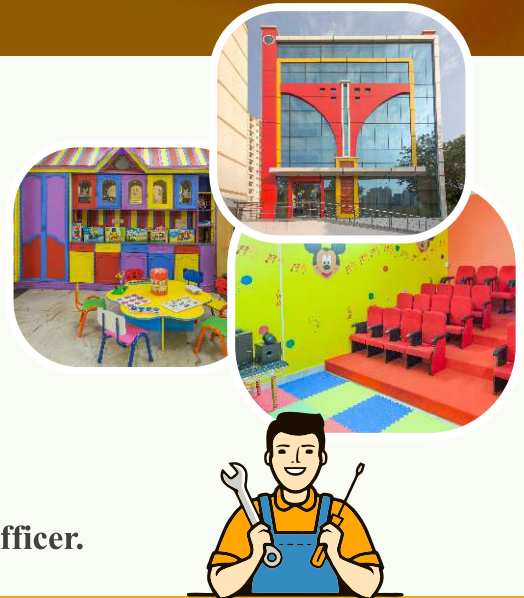


UPDATION IN INFRASTRUCTURE

Activity CORNER



The festival of Diwali is around the corner and we are ready to embrace the essence of Diwali by engaging our preschoolers in this joyful and creative '**Diya Painting Activity**'. This activity will allow the preschoolers to practice fine-motor skills and hand-eye coordination.

Material required for the Activity:

- Clay diyas (3-4)
- Non-toxic, washable acrylic paints
- Paintbrushes
- Tissue papers (for cleaning brushes)
- Newspaper
- Paint palettes or Paper plates
- Glitter, sequins and beads
- Glue
- Tea light candles

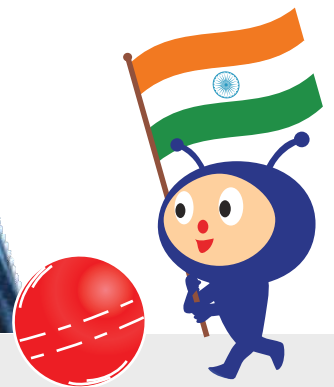
Teachers will—

- Guide children to cover the table with newspapers to protect it from paint spills.
- Briefly introduce the concept of Diwali and tradition of lighting diyas to our preschoolers.
- Encourage them to be creative and use their imagination. The tiny tots can paint diyas with traditional patterns using paintbrush and colourful acrylic paints of their choices.
- Ask them to keep aside the painted diyas and let them dry completely.
- Guide preschoolers to glue glitter, sequins or beads to the diyas to make them look more festive.
- Help them to put the tea light candles in diyas to give a final look.

Our young ones will feel proud to see the beautiful diyas painted by them!



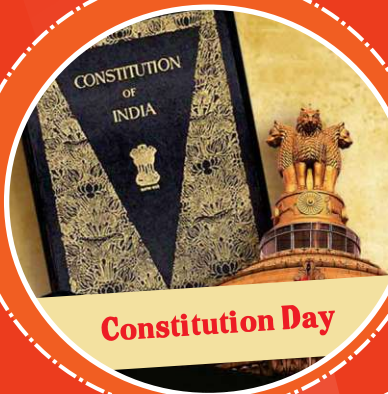
FAMOUS PERSONALITY BORN IN NOVEMBER



Jhulan Goswami is an Indian Cricketer widely regarded as one of the greatest players of the Indian Women's Cricket Team. She was the first member of her family to participate in sports and her grandmother supported her.

Jhulan is simply unstoppable and has been in the game for more than twenty years. She made her debut in the Indian Women's Cricket Team in 2002 and is unstoppable since then.

Jhulan Goswami is the only Woman Cricketer to score 1000 runs in one-day internationals. Jhulan has received numerous awards and recognitions for her contribution to sports. She has been honoured with the Arjuna Award and the Padma Shri, two of India's prestigious Civilian Awards. Her career longevity, dedication and contribution to Indian Women's Cricket has made her a legendary figure across the nation.

Wangala Festival

Wangala Festival is a vibrant and culturally significant harvest festival celebrated in the month of November every year. The Garo tribe in the North-Eastern state of Meghalaya celebrates the Wangala Festival with great enthusiasm. This festival is also known as the 100 Drums Wangala Festival because it often involves the participation of a hundred traditional Garo drums known as 'Dama' or 'Nagaras'. The Wangala Festival signifies the beginning of winter and the end of a time of labour, which brings good output to the fields.
